








First half of the school year



Top 10 Things to Work on With Your Child

- ✧ Say and write First and Last Name
- ✧ How to use the bathroom and wash their hands
- ✧ How to tie their own shoes or provide velcro ties
- ✧ ABC's letter names and sounds
- ✧ Count and identify numbers 0-20
- ✧ Read a book to your child every day
- ✧ Hold a pencil correctly and draw lines and circles
- ✧ Ask for help
- ✧ Identify shapes and colors
- ✧ Fine-motor skill development, Scissors
